<u>Dates</u>: Tuesday, February 18 through Friday, February 28, 2020, including a week-long exhibit and sale. We've scheduled our "Paint & Photo" plein air event for February to assure the best possible facilities and locations, considering Tarpon's busy arts scene. The cost to participate will be \$45.00, non-refundable, paid in advance. See form on back.

Registration will be held at the Tarpon Springs Heritage Museum, 100 Beekman Lane, Tarpon Springs, on Tuesday, February 18 at 10:00. Painters and Photographers will sign in at this time. We will share a cup of coffee and provide event information. We will have maps, restaurant info, etc., available so you can become familiar with the city.

<u>Important note for painters:</u> Bring with you to registration all the paper, canvas, etc., that you think you will be using. Materials will be stamped so that we know work is done within the 3 ½ days of the event. However, if during the event, you need additional materials stamped, someone will be at the Heritage Museum each day from 9 to 4.

Quick Draw and Cookout: The Quick Draw will be held on <u>Thursday</u>, <u>February 20th at Fred Howard Park</u>, <u>Shelter 6</u>, 1700 Sunset Drive, from 1 – 4 p.m. A cookout will follow the Quick Draw.

Painting & photo work <u>must</u> be done during <u>any</u>, <u>or all</u> of Tuesday, February 18 (following registration), through noon, February 21, and <u>be done on location in Tarpon Springs</u>. Paintings must be done without the aid of photography.

During the event, painters may bring finished, framed work done during the week into a "preview room" at the Heritage Museum. This facility will be open to the public as well, so, if you have finished work, you may leave it for sale. Photographers are welcome to leave framed prints of work done during the week for the public to view for purchase. These works will be brought to the Museum for the show & reception. Be prepared with all your framing needs.

By Friday, February 21st, no later than noon, all painters and photographers should bring one framed piece with hanging hardware firmly attached to the Heritage Museum in Craig Park. Judging will take place Friday afternoon. The reception and award presentation will be held on Friday evening, February 21, from 6 – 8 p.m. The week-long Paint & Photo Tarpon Springs Exhibit will follow at the Heritage Museum.
